Proclamation

"CONFEDERATE HISTORY AND HERITAGE MONTH"
April 2012

WHEREAS: Augustine Warner Robins, for whom the city was named, was the son of Confederate hero William Todd Robins, who rose from a private in the Virginia 9th Cavalry to commander of the Virginia 24th Cavalry regiment during the war; and,
